

# Education Day on Obesity & DASO annual obesity meeting November 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> 2023

The annual education day on obesity and the DASO annual Obesity Meeting, will take place the 2<sup>nd</sup> to the 4<sup>th</sup> of November 2023. The conference will be held in Nyborg, Denmark, Østerøvej 121, 5800 Nyborg, and will bring together medical doctors, dietitians, health care professionals, and multidisciplinary researchers engaged in obesity research.
